Tako vključevanje okoljevarstvenih vidikov v planiranje na ravni države kot vrednotenje variant v prostorskem razvoju prometa izhajata iz predpostavke, da obstajajo v okolju območja, ki so za različne dejavnosti različno občutljiva/ ranljiva.

Poznavanje teh območij lahko prispeva k bolj okoljsko naravnanim odločitvam pri usmerjanju razvoja v prostoru. S pomočjo modelov ranljivosti, ki simulirajo nastanek potencialnih vplivov na vsako sestavino okolja, izdelajo karte ranljivosti za relevantne posege. Tako nastanejo karte z označenimi bolj ali manj občutljivimi območji. Študija ranljivosti upošteva vse tri osnovne skupine varstvenih zahtev: varstvo narave same po sebi, varstvo neobnovljivih virov in varstvo bivanjskega okolja.

Oba prispevka sta naletela na velik odziv. Razpravljali so predvsem o predstavljenih teoretičnih izhodiščih, o specifičnem prostorskem in pravnem okviru študij, o organiziranosti in kakovosti uporabljenih bank podatkov.

Delo delavnic

Delo je potekalo v petih delovnih skupinah in sicer:

- Delavnica 1 – Stanovanjska prenova in strategije mestne prenove
- Delavnica 2 – Nove stanovanjske politike in nova vloga raziskav na stanovanjskem področju v državah v tranziciji
- Delavnica 3 – Organizacija in financiranje stanovanjske gradnje
- Delavnica 4 – Regionalna in urbana stanovanjska politika: migracije in mobilnost prebivalstva in
- Delavnica 5 – Stanovanjska ekonomika

Vsaka delavnica je imela dva koordinatorja in sicer enega strokovnjaka s stanovanjskega področja iz Slovenije ter enega iz tujine. Menili smo, da bo na ta način zagotovljeno ravnotežje med posameznimi področji in problematikami.

V okviru navedenih petih delavnic je bilo predstavljenih 75 refe-

ratov. Povzetki vseh referatov so objavljeni v brošuri povzetkov (Book of Abstracts). Originali referatov so na voljo v knjižnici Urbanističnega inštituta RS oziroma bodo objavljeni v zborniku.
